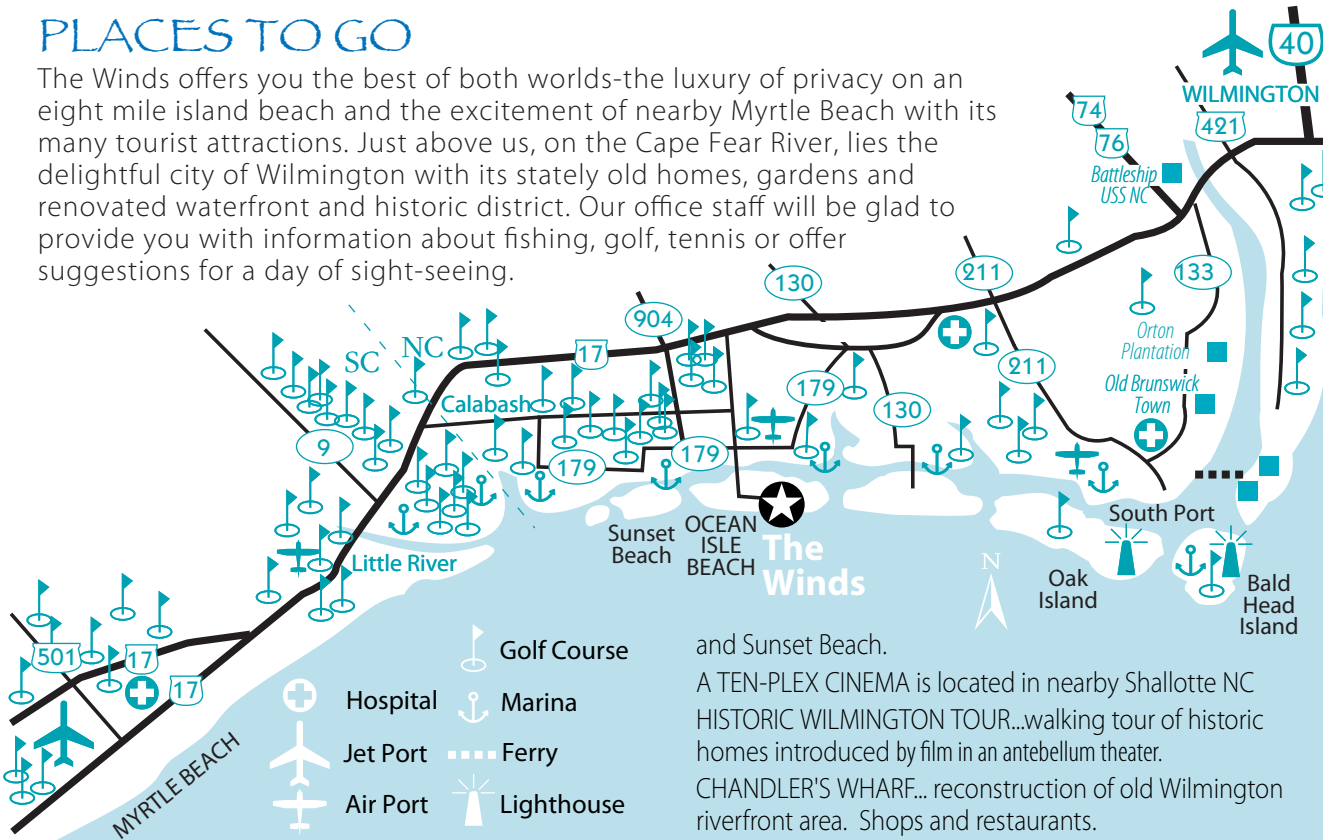


## PLACES TO GO

**ORTON PLANTATION...** old rice plantation on Cape Fear River. "Gone With The Wind" house and gardens.  
**BRUNSWICK TOWN HISTORIC SITE ...** excavated colonial town, small archaeological museum & nature trail.  
**USS N.C. BATTLESHIP MEMORIAL ...** gallant warrior from World War II. Sound and light show in season.  
**SOUTHPORT...** quaint seaport town where sea captains lived. Area once frequented by notorious "Gentleman" pirate, Stede Bonnet. Fort Johnson, prerevolutionary fort. Take the ferry across to the Cape Fear peninsula.  
**N.C. AQUARIUM ...** aquarium, displays, films.  
**FORT FISHER ...** major Confederate bastion. Its fall closed last Confederate port to daring blockade runners.  
**MUSEUM OF THE COASTAL CAROLINAS...** located only a little over a mile from The Winds... the regional flora and fauna of both the sea and the land are displayed.  
**PLANETARIUM...** located nearby between Ocean Isle Beach

and Sunset Beach.

A TEN-PLEX CINEMA is located in nearby Shallotte NC  
**HISTORIC WILMINGTON TOUR...**walking tour of historic homes introduced by film in an antebellum theater.  
**CHANDLER'S WHARF...** reconstruction of old Wilmington riverfront area. Shops and restaurants.  
**THE COTTON EXCHANGE ...** restored building now houses smart boutiques, art galleries, and eateries.  
**RESTAURANTS...** many choices in Wilmington, the Brunswick Islands, Calabash, Little River, Myrtle Beach.  
**FISHING VILLAGES...** Southport, Calabash, Varnumtown, Shallotte Point, Little River.  
**GAUSE LANDING...**live oaks dripping with Spanish Moss bend over the road leading to the waterway. In 1791 George Washington visited the Gause Plantation. The house is no more.  
**BROOKGREEN GARDENS...** below Myrtle Beach. Outdoor sculpture museum in beautiful garden setting. Also, in Wilmington visit Airlie Gardens.  
**BAREFOOT LANDING...** on Hwy 17 in North Myrtle Beach. SC's number one attraction. A huge variety of shops and restaurants.  
**BROADWAY AT THE BEACH ...** Myrtle Beach. Shops, shows and restaurants.

**SWIMMING ...** choose either Atlantic Ocean or one of our outdoor pools or our heated indoor pool.  
**WHIRLPOOL ...** enjoy one of our whirlpool spas  
**SUNBATHING ...** our beach faces south and has sun all day  
**SHELLING ...** sanddollars, olive shells, angel wings etc.  
**SAILING ...** sailboat rentals in season at The Winds.  
**SHUFFLEBOARD ...** at The Winds, lighted for night play.  
**KEEPING FIT...** use the equipment in our exercise room.  
**JOGGING ...** along 8 miles of beach & quiet island roads.  
**GOLF...** on a choice of more than ninety 18-hole courses. 30 of which are within a 15 minute drive.  
**BIKING ...** free bikes for guests at The Winds.  
**FISHING ...** surf, pier, charter, or party boat.  
**CRABBING ...** in the waterway or in the sound.  
**BIRDWATCHING ...** Pelicans, Osprey, Egrets, Herons.  
**SIGHTSEEING ...** historic houses, plantations & gardens.  
**JET SKI RENTALS ...** at Ocean Isle Marina on the causeway.  
**MINIATURE GOLF...** Free putting green for Winds guests.  
**WATER AEROBICS** is offered at The Winds in season.  
**COOKOUTS ...** at The Winds oceanfront picnic tables.  
**DINING...** seafood, low country cooking & gourmet dining.  
**DANCING...**island restaurants & Myrtle Beach night spots.  
**CRUISES ...** sightseeing, dinner and moonlight cruises out of Calabash and Little River. Cape Fear River paddlewheel steamer cruises out of Wilmington.  
**SHOPPING ...** island shops and boutiques, theme shopping villages and Myrtle Beach and Wilmington malls.  
**COUNTRY MUSIC ...** The Alabama Theater, Dolly Parton's Dixie Stampede and many others offer music shows and top performers in nearby Myrtle Beach  
**BOWLING ...** in Shallotte on 179 & on US17 in Little River.  
**VOLLEY BALL ...** on The Winds court or beachfront.
